

WHITE NOISE | WHITE LIGHT

INTERACTIVE SOUND AND LIGHT INSTALLATION
SPONSORED BY THE ATHENS OLYMPIC COMMITTEE
ATHENS, GREECE 2004

White Noise / White Light was one of nine interactive urban installations commissioned and installed for the Athens 2004 Olympics. Part of the programmed 'Listen to Athens' route, the project inserted a luminous interactive sound and landscape within an urban public plaza to create a choreographed field in flux. Semi-flexible fiber-optic strands, arranged in a fading grid, responded to the movement of pedestrians through the field by emitting white noise and white light.
